Project examples

1-4 Capital Interchange Way, Brentford:

Preparation of Cultural Heritage input to a joint Visual, Townscape and Heritage ES Chapter and Heritage Statement to support an application for two 16-storey towers within the setting of Kew WHS and other highly designated heritage assets.

Private householder, Slough: Successfully negotiated a retrospective planning and listed building consent for a private householder thereby de-escalating the Council's threat of prosecution and enforcement action.

Baltic Wharf (Powerhub), Maidstone: Successfully appeared as expert witness at a public inquiry appealing the non-determination of an application to convert a redundant grade II listed former factory by Wallis Gilbert and Partners to a mixed-use development.
